### Luxembourg: 800 charging stations with Chargy and Plugsurfing



**BERLIN, 12.12.17 - Chargy has set itself the ambitious goal of equipping Luxembourg with 800 charging stations by 2020. In addition to their accessibility via the Luxembourg card mKaart, all current and future stations are compatible with Plugsurfing via the app or [the Charging Key](#).**

Within two years, a total of 800 charging points will be installed by Chargy throughout the Luxembourg territory: 400 on public car parks and 400 on P+R car parks, allowing easy access to public transport. A true electric revolution to which Plugsurfing is delighted to participate.
